As indicated, yours is a unique and professional eP, supported by original contributions like audio reflections, layered with multiple levels of meaning, with links often converging.

Rich survey of courses and artifacts- I appreciate your weaves among your metaphor, artifact, reflection and coursework, sharing of narrative and discussion of your metaphor.

I appreciate your reflections at the meta-cognitive level, permeating throughout your eP. I also appreciate the depth of your reflections. I note you included instructions to help with navigation and converted your documents into pdfs, to be viewed across platforms, bypassing issues with formatting, etc.

Your eP derives its originality in multiple ways: e.g.: 3 column formats, pages, categories, links that network your categories, etc.- originality that presents your readers with unique navigational experiences.

Suggestions:

Artifacts:

530- excerpt begins in body of original document (**my choice**). We might need more context to appreciate the significance of the table- as reflection, in situ. - **Considered**.

500- titles of excerpt and document do not match (**my choice**), not sure of need for truncating text- that has implications, requiring one to retrieve the full document. - **Considered**.

510- artifact clicked from Pages, as mind map launches as only artifact, link to content found elsewhere in eP. - **Considered** (although not quite clear on the issue here).

All in all, an original and unique eP that pushes innovation borders!
