Navigation

- Overall your eP is well organized and focused. The choice of blog template is appropriate as well as your choice of graphics.
- Your top navigation bar is clearly titled so it was intuitive to me how you organized your site. Your Guided Tour worked to clarify the organization and is a useful and well-done support.
- You might also consider doing a text description of your eP navigation embedded on the Guided Tour page.

Rational and Framework

- Your audience and purpose are clearly outlined on your Guided Tour page and your guiding questions on the Home page.
- It is apparent to me that you entered the MET program with a clear focus to making your learning relevant to your current position. This is obvious from the metaphor you have chosen and all of the artifacts you have selected. Everything selected and included has a media, film and/or student-centred focus. Collectively, this selection has resulted in a body of work that fits nicely together in one succinct package.
- I suggest that your “My ETEC Portfolio” section be posted in a more prevalent spot – perhaps on your Guided Tour page (right now I think it is a blog post). This section is a statement of your rationale, goal and assessment so is essential to providing your readers/viewers with a particular lens, while travelling through your eP.
- You have highlighted your videos completed in the program by giving them their own page. Initially, I was not convinced this was necessary but in the end I think this page works to emphasize your metaphor.

Artifacts and Connection to Theme or Question

- I questioned whether or not your Academic Reflections should be housed on your MET Courses page or on the Artifacts page. After reviewing your eP more thoroughly, I believe they are suited to their current location. You might think about highlighting the link to these reflections in some way though. As well you might want to include the context of these reflections. I think many are excerpts or full discussion posts from various courses. It might bring some clarity for your audience as to why these were written.
- Your audio reflections are certainly fitting to your theme! I really like that you included these. You clearly state why you selected the artifact and how it contributed to your learning. Some reflections could be a bit longer but I would not be concerned with this at this point, as they are polished pieces of work that are of high quality!

Mechanics (Grammar, Spelling, Syntax)

- Overall your writing speaks to your audience and has been written in a professional manner.

A couple of spelling errors I came across:

Under tab, Guided Tour:

- After Here is Your Map! – It should say “how to navigate **through**”
- I like that you included the minutes of your Guided Tour. Viewers will appreciate knowing how long they will be watching. In your text you mention that the video is 5 min but it is actually more like 4 minutes, so you might want to adjust.
- After The Audience – It should say “**prospective** employers”.
- You might want to remove the underline from the heading “The Audience as well.

Under tab, MET Courses:

- Capitalization is needed on the ETEC*510 course title to be consistent with the rest.

Title of eP

- This is somewhat subjective but you might consider capitalizing the words in your eP title: “Active Learning through Media Literacy”.

Chantal, it is clear that you really enjoy learning, particularly about technology, new media and film. You have certainly done a great job on your eP!
